These products are approved only if used in accordance with the label directions and applicable import protocols and health certificates.

List of APHIS-Approved Products for Livestock Imports

APHIS approval is based on supporting scientific evidence that the products are effective for the prevention and/or treatment of NWS larval infestation. Approvals are species-specific, as noted below, and **only** for pre-export treatment of these animals when seeking to import into the United States.

Products containing active ingredients in addition to those listed in the table below or in different combinations **must** be approved by APHIS prior to use. Products may not contain any ingredient banned for use in the United States. For more information, contact laie@usda.gov.
