APHIS recognizes **only** that area of Cyprus that is labeled “Area controlled by Cyprus Government (Greek Cypriot area),” “Dhekelia,” and “Akrotiri” on the map above as

- low risk for classical swine fever;
- free of foot-and-mouth disease;*
- free of swine vesicular disease;
- negligible risk for bovine spongiform encephalopathy; and
- included in the APHIS-defined European Poultry Trade Region.

* Effective January 23, 2026, the area controlled by Cyprus Government (Greek Cypriot area), Dhekelia, and Akrotiri in the map above are under temporary restrictions for foot-and-mouth disease.
