I hereby certify that following due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, the pet bird(s) covered under this health certificate comply with the following statements:

1. The pet birds do not originate from and have not transited through a control zone established by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) due to outbreaks of Newcastle disease or Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) and are not currently under quarantine nor have any restrictions to their movement.⁽¹⁾
OR
The pet birds originate from and/or will transit a control zone established by the CFIA due to outbreaks of Newcastle disease or HPAI and arrangements have been made for quarantine after importation.⁽¹⁾
2. Insofar as it is possible to determine, the pet birds were not exposed to Newcastle disease, HPAI, chlamydiosis, or other communicable disease of poultry during the ninety (90) days immediately preceding export.
3. The pet birds were examined within the thirty (30) days immediately preceding the date of export and showed no evidence of communicable disease of poultry.
4. The pet birds were not vaccinated against any H5 or H7 subtype of avian influenza.
5. The pet birds were either:
Not vaccinated against Newcastle disease.⁽¹⁾
OR
Vaccinated against Newcastle disease at least twenty-one (21) days prior to export.⁽¹⁾
6. The exporter has been advised that the pet birds must be placed in new or appropriately sanitized shipping containers at the premises where they are kept prior to movement for export.

⁽²⁾ U.S.-origin pet birds weighing over 100 grams must be identified by microchip, leg band, or tattoo to be eligible for home quarantine upon return, with the individual identification of each bird listed on this certificate. Individual identification is not required for other pet birds but may be provided.
